### Regional Immigration Office

As you know, last year, we were required to send documentation in to that effect. This will be an ongoing exercise where they can randomly check on permits. We advise you to be sure your children are in compliance at all times.

Please be sure your child's teacher is advised and the HOD is aware of who collects your child each day from school. Should there be any change, we need to have that in writing and verbally so that we maintain the safety of our students.
