## Valentine's Day @ TLCS



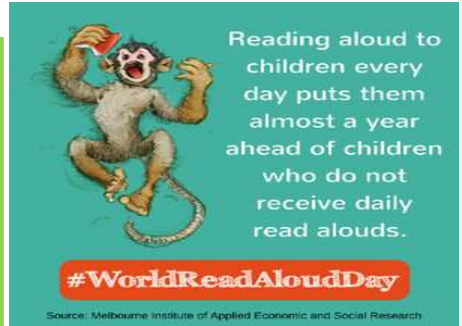
